access /ˈækses/ (verb) to find information, especially on a computer access (noun) – accessible (adjective)

blog /blog/ (noun) a regularly updated personal website or web page, usually written in an informal style blog (verb) مدونة

calculation /kælˌkjuːˈleɪʃən/ (noun) a way of using numbers in order to find out an amount, price or value calculate (verb) حساب

computer chip /kəmˈpju:tə tʃɪp/ (noun) a small piece inside a computer which stores information via an electric current رقاقة كمبيوتر

email exchange /ˈiːmeəl ɪksˈtʃeɪndʒ/ (noun) a series of emails between two or more people, each email generally a reply to the previous one email (verb) تبادل الإيميل

filter /ˈfiltə/ (noun) a program that checks whether certain content on a web page should be displayed to the viewer filter (verb)

floppy disk /ˈflopi dɪsk/ (noun) a flexible, removable magnetic disk that stores computer information قرص مرن

ICT /ˈaɪ siː ˌtiː/ (n.abbrev.) Information and Communication Technology تكنولوجيا المعلومات

identity fraud /ar'dentiti: fro:d/ (noun) illegal actions using the identity of someone else, normally to buy things

PC /pi: 'si:/ (noun) an abbreviation for personal computer, a computer that is used by one person at a time

post /pəʊst/ (verb) to put a message or document on the Internet so that other people can see it post (noun)

privacy settings /ˈpraɪvəsi ˈsetɪŋz/ (noun) controls available on social networking sites which let you decide who can see what information اعدادات الخصوصية

program /'prəʊgræm/ (noun) a set of مج کمبیوتر instructions enabling a computer to function; programme (noun) content which is intended to be listened to on radio or watched on television برنامج تلفزیونی او اذاعی

rely on /rɪˈlaɪ ˌɒn/ (phrasal verb) to have trust or confidence in something or someone reliable (adjective) يعتمد على

sat nav system /sæt næv 'sɪstəm/ (noun)
satellite navigation system a system of
computers and satellites, used in cars and
other places that tells you where something
is, where you are or how to get to a place

security settings /səˈkjuːrɪti ˈsetɪŋz/ (noun) controls available on computer programs which let you protect your computer from viruses

smartphone /smɑ:tfəʊn/ (noun) a mobile phone with advanced computing technology هاتف ذکي

social media /ˈsəʊʃəl ˈmiːdiə/ (noun) social interaction between people and communities on websites or blogs وسائل التواصل الاجتماعي

tablet computer /ˈtæblɪt kəmˈpjuːtə/ (noun) a mobile computer, with a touch screen, processor and battery all in one unit

user /ˈjuːzə/ (noun) a person who uses a product or service, especially a computer or another machine مستخدم

web-building program /web 'bıldıŋ 'prəugræm/ (noun) a software that helps you to create a website برنامج بناء المواقع

web hosting /web ˌhəʊstɪŋ/ (noun) the business of housing, serving and maintaining files for one or more websites ستضافة المواقع

whiteboard /ˈwaɪtbɔːd/ (noun) a touchscreen computer program that enables you to draw sketches, write and present ideas and talks to colleagues or students لوح ذكي

World Wide Web /ws:ld ward web/ (noun) an information system, known as the Internet, which allows documents to be connected to other documents, and for people to search for information by moving from one document to another شبكة الانترنت العالمية

acupuncture /ˈækjuːˌpʌŋktʃə/ (noun) a system of complementary medicine in which fine needles are inserted in the skin at specific points

allergy /ˈælədʒi/ (noun) a reaction of the immune system when it is sensitive to something; this reaction comes in the form of sneezing, itchy eyes or a skin rash allergic adjective) ما المحافظة

apparatus /عpp:reitəs/ (noun) the technical equipment or machinery needed for a particular purpose

arthritis /ɑːˈθraɪtɪs/ (noun) a disease causing painful inflammation and stiffness of the joints arthritic (adjective)

artificial /مندناآآآآآآآآآ (adjective) made or produced by human beings rather than occurring naturally artifice (noun) – artificially (adverb)

bionic /baɪˈɒnɪk/ (adjective) describing a limb or body part that is electronically or mechanically powered

bounce back /bauns bæk/ (phrasal verb) to start to be successful again after a difficult time يرتد

cancerous /ˈkænˌsərəs/ (adjective) something that has or can cause cancer, a very serious disease in which cells in the body begin to grow abnormally cancer (noun)

career /kəˈrɪə/ (noun) a job undertaken for a significant period of a person's life and with opportunities for progress مهنة

<mark>coma</mark> /ˈkəʊmə/ (*noun)* a state of غيبوبة unconsciousness caused by a certain injury and that lasts for an extended period of time

commitment /kəˈmɪtmənt/ (noun) a promise to do something or to behave in a particular way commit (verb) – committed (adjective)

complementary medicine /ˌkɒmpləˈmentri ˈmedsən/ (noun) medical treatment which provides an alternative to scientific medical practices complement (verb) علاج بديل

conventional /kən'ven∫ənəl/ (adjective) having been used for a long time and is considered usual convention (noun) – conventionally (adverb) تقليدي

<u>cope</u> <u>with</u> /kəʊp wɪð/ (phrasal verb) to deal successfully with, or handle, a situation يتاقلم

cross /krɒs/ (adjective) angry or annoyed غاضب decline /dɪˈklaɪn/ (verb) to decrease in quantity or importance decline (noun) ينخفض

dementia /dɪˈmenʃə/ (noun) a mental illness the symptoms of which are problems with memory, personality changes and problems with reasoning خرف

drug /drʌɡ/ (noun) a medicine or a substance used for making medicines دواء

expansion /ɪkˈspænˌʃən/ (noun) the act of making something bigger expand (verb) توسع

feel blue /fiːl blu:/ (verb phrase) [idiom] to feel sad يشعر بالحزن

focus on /ˈfəʊkəs ɒn/ (phrasal verb) to direct your attention or effort at something specific focus (noun) – focused (adjective) يركز على

have the green light /hæv ðə gri: n laɪt/ (verb phrase) [idiom] to have or give permission to go ahead with something or for something to happen

healthcare /'helθˌkeə/ (noun) the prevention or treatment of illness by doctors, dentists, psychologists, etc. رعاية صحية

herbal remedy /ˈhɜːbəl ˈremədiː/ (noun) an extract or mixture of a plant used to prevent, alleviate, or cure disease remedy (verb) – remedial (adjective)

homoeopathy /ˌhəʊmi'ɒpəθi/ (noun) a system of complementary medicine in which illnesses are treated by minute doses of herbs and other natural substances العلاج المثلى

immunisation / المارة المارة

implant /'mpla:nt/ (noun) a piece of tissue, prosthetic device, or other object implanted in the body implant (verb) زراعة

life expectancy /laɪf ɪkˌspektənsi/ (noun) the length of time that a person or animal is expected to live expect (verb) – expectation (noun) العمر المتوقع

limb /lɪm/ (noun) arm or leg of a person طرف malaria /məˈleəriə/ (noun) a dangerous disease transmitted by mosquitoes

medical trial /ˈmedɪkəl ˈtraɪəl/ (noun) trial to evaluate the effectiveness and safety of medications trial (verb) تجارب دوائية

migraine /ˈmaɪgreɪn/ (noun) a very bad headache which often comes with a feeling of sickness and problems with vision صداع شدید

mortality /ˌmɔːˈtæləti/ (noun) death, especially on a large scale (e.g. infant mortality); the rate of deaths that occur (mortality rate) mortal (noun and adjective) – mortally (adverb)

MRI /em air 'ai/ (noun) (Magnetic Resonance Imaging) a scan that uses strong magnetic fields to make a picture of the inside of someone's body for medical reasons العلاج بالرنين المغناطيسي

obese /əʊ'biːs/ (adjective) extremely fat, in a way that is dangerous to your health obesity (noun)

optimistic /ˌoptəˈmɪstɪk/ (adjective) believing that good things will happen in the future optimism, optimist (noun) متفائل

option /ˈɒpʃən/ (noun) something that is or may be chosen optional (adjective) خيار

out of the blue /aut əv ðə blu:/ (adjective) [idiom] apparently from nowhere; unexpectedly

outpatient /ˈaʊʔˌpeɪʃənt/ (noun) someone who goes to a hospital for treatment but does not stay for the night مريض غير مقيم

paediatric /ˌpiːdiˈætrɪk/ (adjective) describing the area of medicine that deals with children and their illnesses paediatrics, paediatrician (noun)

pill /pɪl/ (noun) a small round piece of medicine to be swallowed whole عبة دواء

practitioner /prækˈtɪʃənə/ (noun) someone who is qualified or registered to practise a particular occupation or profession practise (verb) – practical (adjective) – practically (adverb)

prosthetic /ˌprəsˈθetɪk/ (noun) an artificial body part; ~ (adjective) limb describing an artificial body part prosthetics (noun)

publicise /'pʌblɪsaɪz/ (verb) to give information about something to the public, so that they know about it publicity (noun)

علاج الأشعاع radiotherapy /ˌreɪdiəʊˈθerəpi/ (noun) the use of controlled amounts of radiation (a form of energy) to treat disease, especially cancer

raise /reɪz/ (verb) ~ a question to bring up a problem or cast doubt on something يرفع red-handed /red'hændɪd/ (adjective) [idiom] in the act of doing something wrong متلبس

reputation /repjotersən/ (noun) the common opinion that people have about someone or something repute (verb)

scanner /'skænə/ (noun) a medical instrument that uses radiography to produce images of the insides of the human body scan (verb) ماسح

sceptical /'skeptɪkəl/ (adjective) having doubts; not easily convinced sceptic, scepticism (noun)

<mark>see red</mark> /si: red/ (*verb phrase*) [idiom] to be angry

setback /setbæk/ (noun) a problem that delays or stops progress, or makes a situation worse

side effect /saɪd ɪˈfekt/ (noun) effects of يعيق medicine on your body in addition to curing pain or illness اثار حانية

sponsor /'sponsə/ (verb) to financially support a person or an event sponsor (noun) – sponsored (adjective) يمول

strenuous /strenjuəs/ (adjective) using or needing a lot of effort

stroke /strəʊk/ (noun) an illness when a blood tube in your brain bursts or is blocked, resulting in the brain being unable to function normally سكتة دماغية

symptom /'sɪmptəm/ (noun) a physical problem that might indicate a disease اعراض viable /'vaɪəbəl/ (adjective) effective and able to be successful viability (noun)

ward /wo:d/ (noun) a room in a hospital, especially for patients needing similar kinds of care ward (verb) قسم

white elephant /waɪt 'eləfənt/ (noun phrase) [idiom] something that has cost a lot of money but has no useful purpose بدون فائدة

algebra /ˈældʒɪbrə/ (noun) a type of mathematics system where letters and symbols are used to represent numbers algebraic (adjective)

arithmetic /əˈrɪθmətɪk/ (noun) the branch of mathematics concerned with numerical calculations such as addition, subtraction, multiplication and division

artificially-created / منداناتها kri'ented/
(adjective) not real or not made of natural
things but made to be like something that
is real or natural create (verb) – creation
(noun)

<mark>breathtaking</mark> /ˈbreθˌteɪkɪŋ/ *(adjective)* wonderful, awe-inspiring يخطف الإنفا*س*

camera obscura /ˈkæmrə ɒbˈskjʊərə/ (noun)
Latin for 'dark room'; an optical device that led to photography and the invention of the camera الغرفة المعتمة

carbon-neutral /ˈkɑːbən ˈnjuːtrəl/ (adjective) not affecting the total amount of carbon dioxide in Earth's atmosphere neutralise (verb) – neutrality (noun)

ceramics /ˌsəˈræmɪks/ (noun) the art of producing something made from clay or porcelain, or the clay or porcelain items themselves ceramic (adjective)

composition /ˌkɒmpəˈzɪʃən/ (noun) [of music] a piece of music that someone has written compose (verb)

conservatory /kən'sɜːˌvətri/ (noun) (American usage for British conservatoire) a school where people are trained in music or acting معهد موسيقي

craftsman /'krɑ:ftsˌmən/ (noun) someone who is very skilled at a particular craft, a job or an activity that requires skills and in which they make things with their hands

criticise /ˈkrɪtɪsaɪz/ (verb) to judge (something) with disapproval; to evaluate or analyse (something) critic, criticism (noun) – critical (adjective)

demonstration /ˌdemənˈstreɪʃən/ (noun) an act of explaining and showing how to do something, or how something works demonstrate (verb) شرح

desalination /di:sælrnesʃən/ (noun) the process of removing salt from sea water so that it can be used desalinate (verb) تحلية الماء

fountain pen /ˈfaontɪn pen/ (noun) a pen which needs ink cartridge refills and the nib of which takes ink from these cartridges to write

furnishings /ˈfɜːmɪʃɪŋz/ (plural noun) the furniture and other things, such as curtains, in a room furnish (verb)

geometry /dʒi'ɒmətri/ (noun) the branch of mathematics concerned with the properties, relationships and measurement of points, lines, curves and surfaces geometric (adjective) – geometrically (adverb)

glassblowing /gla:sbləvɪŋ/ (noun) the art of shaping a piece of hot, melted glass by blowing air into it through a tube blow (verb) نفخ الزجاج

grid /grɪd/ (noun) [energy grid] a system of wires through which electricity is connected to different power stations across a region شبکة

ground-breaking /graund'breikin/ (adjective) new, innovative break (verb)

hanging /ˈhæˌŋɪŋ/ (noun) a large piece of cloth that is hung on a wall as a decoration hang (verb) تعلیقات

inheritance /ɪnˈherɪtəns/ (noun) money or things that you get from someone after they die inherit (verb) ارث inoculation /ɪˌnɒkjəˈleɪʃən/ (noun) an injection you can have to protect you from a disease inoculate (verb) – inoculable (adjective)

installation /ˌɪnstəˈleɪʃən/ (noun) an art exhibit often involving video or moving parts install (verb) ترکیب

irrigate /۱٫۲۲'geɪt/ (verb) to supply land with water so that crops and plants will grow irrigation (noun)

lifelike /ˈlaɪflaɪk/ (adjective) very similar to the person or thing represented نابض بالحياة

mathematician /ˌmæθməˈtɪʃən/ (noun) a person who studies Mathematics to a very complex level mathematics (noun) – mathematical (adjective)

megaproject /megəˈprodʒekt/ (noun) a very large, expensive, ambitious business project minaret /mɪnəˈret/ (noun) the tall, thin tower of a mosque from which Muslims are called to prayer

musical harmony /ˈmjuːzɪkəl ˈhɑːməni/ (noun) opposed to literat a pleasant sound in music, made by playing or singing a group of different notes together harmonious (adjective) – harmonise (verb) نناغم flour طواحين الهواء

outweigh /ˌauʔˈweɪ/ (verb) to be more important than something else يتخطى

pedestrian /pədestriən/ (noun) someone who is walking, especially along a street or another place that is used by cars pedestrian (adjective)

performing <mark>arts</mark> /pəˈfɔːmɪŋ ɑːts/ (noun) a type of art that can combine acting, dance, painting and film to express an idea فنون ادائية

philosopher /fəˈlɒsəfə/ (noun) someone who studies and writes philosophy professionally, or an undergraduate student of Philosophy philosophise (verb) – philosophical (adjective)

physician /fəˈzɪʃən/ (noun) someone qualified to practise medicine, especially one who specialises in diagnosis and treatment طبيب

polymath /ˈpɒlɪˌmæθ/ (noun) someone who has a lot of knowledge about many different subjects

qualify /ˈkwɒlɪfaɪ/ (verb) to be entitled to a particular benefit or privilege by fulfilling a necessary condition qualification (noun) يؤ هل

restore /rɪˈstɔː/ (verb) to repair or renovate a building, work of art, etc., so as to bring it back to its original condition restoration (noun)

revolutionise /ˌrevəˈluːʃənaɪz/ (verb) to completely change the way people do something or think about something revolution (noun) – revolutionary (adjective)

sand artist /sænd 'a:tist/ (noun) someone who models sand into an artistic form sand art (noun) فنان رمال

showcase /ˈʃəʊkeɪs/ (verb) to exhibit or display showcase (noun) يعرض

sustainability /səˌsteɪnəˈbɪləti:/ (noun) the state of being able to continue forever, or for a very long time; for example, the sustainability of the environment involves emitting less pollution and using less water استدامة sustain (verb) – sustainable (adjective)

textiles /'tekstailz/ (plural noun) types of cloth or woven fabric منسو جات

translation /trænz'leɪʃən/ (noun) the process of converting documents from one language to another translate (verb) – translator (noun) ترحمة

underline مراطع (verb) to emphasise, to highlight تؤکد

vary /'veəri/ (verb) to differ according to the situation variation (noun) – variable (adjective)

visual arts /ˈvɪʒuəl ɑːts/ (noun) art such as painting or sculpture that you look at, as opposed to literature or music فنون بصرية

windmill /ˈwɪnˌmɪl/ (noun) a building that uses its sails and wind power to grind corn into flour طو احدن العواء

<mark>zero-waste</mark> /ˈzɪərəʊ weɪst/ (*adjective*) producing no waste, or having parts that can be reused خالي من النفايات
