Before sitting down to watch his favourite TV detective programme, David Taylor popped out for some crisps - and walked into a real-life police drama.

As he walked towards the local shop with his six-year-old daughter Kerry, he was surrounded by armed police officers. Two marksmen pointed high-powered rifles at him. The street was blocked off by police vehicles and was lit by powerful spotlights. Above the crackle of police radios a voice commanded Mr Taylor to put his hands over his head.

The bewildered father of four obeyed. He was then searched, forced to lie on the ground, handcuffed and taken away to the police station. Tearful Kerry was comforted by her mother Susan, 42, as police explained they were responding to information they had received.

But after a 30-minute interview, police believed Mr Taylor when he told them that they had the wrong house and the man they wanted didn't live there. Yesterday Mr Taylor, of Park Lane, Darlington, said the police were only doing their job and that they had been very apologetic and a bit embarrassed by it all.
