Orangutans once lived all over south-east Asia, but now are only found in the wild on the islands of Borneo and Sumatra. Ten years ago there were approximately forty thousand orangutans in the wild.

The natural habitat of orangutans is the forest, but the forests themselves are in danger. Every year thousands of acres of trees are cut down for wood and to give farmers new land to grow their crops. Also, serious forest fires destroyed large areas of forest in the 1990s. Orangutans depend on the forest for shelter and food.

For people who live in these areas, orangutans can bring in money, but can also be a threat. Because of the reduction in the size of the forests where they live, orangutans now eat some of the crops that the farmers grow. So it is common for people to kill adult orangutans to protect their crops and sell baby orangutans as pets.

Several charity organisations are working to save the orangutans of Borneo and Sumatra. They prepare them for a new life in the wild, then set them free. The work of these charities is expensive, but is making a difference to the survival of the orangutan.
