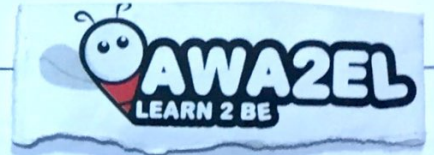




Q1) Read the text carefully then answer the following questions : (10/marks)

In 1877, the Ottoman Empire went to war with Russia. The medics who took care of the wounded soldiers on the Russian side marked their Ambulances with a red cross. This was the symbol used by all countries to protect medics during battles. However, the cross reminded the Ottoman Empire of previous wars against soldiers carrying a similar flag. So the Ottoman officials used a red crescent to mark their ambulances instead. Today, the Red Crescent is very important in responding to disasters such as earthquakes or fires, as well as providing aid to developing countries. A key principle of the organization when providing this aid is neutrality. Red Crescent volunteers work to prevent suffering for everyone - regardless of nationality, race, religion or gender.

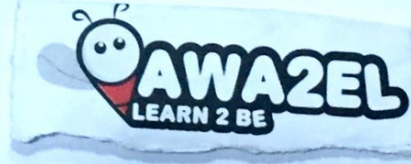
