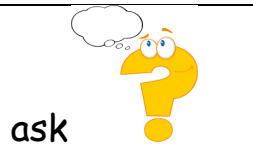
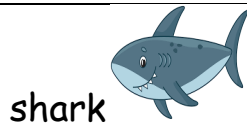
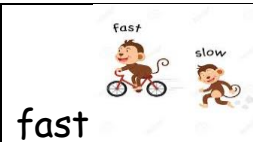

Comparative is used to compare a quality between two people or things.

Noun + verb be (is , are) + adjective + -er + than + noun.

small



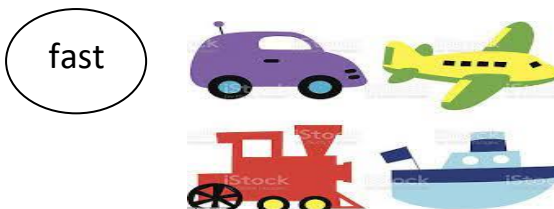
The mouse is smaller than the elephant.

Superlative is used to express the highest quality or degree.

Noun + verb be (is , are) + the + adjective + -est.



Kenan is the tallest boy.



The plane is the fastest.

#Rules of adding (-er) or (-est) :

1-Short adjective ending in (-e) just add (-r) or (-st)

Large larger largest

Nice nicer nicest

2-Short adjective ending in consonant + y, omit (-y) then add (-ier) or (-iest)

Happy happier happiest

Funny funnier funniest

3-Short adjective ending in a vowel + consonant, double the last consonant then add (-er)

Fat fatter fattest

Big bigger biggest
