People have always tried to avoid natural threats; for example, we do not live too close to a river that floods, or on the side of a volcano that may erupt. Scientists cannot stop these threats completely, but **they** can do many things to make them less dangerous.

Rivers flood when the water level rises too high and the river overflows its banks. The Nile flooded for thousands of years until the Aswan High Dam was built in 1970. The dam stops the flooding and generates electric power. It also collects water during the rainy season so that people have water when there is a drought.

A different system protects London from flooding by the River Thames. High tides can bring too much water up the River Thames and this could flood the city. The Thames Barrier was built to protect London from floods.


