Read the following article carefully, and then answer all the questions that follow. Your answer should be based on the article.

Jordan has a very rich cultural heritage thanks to the support of the Department of cultural and the Arts, which was founded in 1966 CE. Since then, the department has built up an exciting ,ongoing programme of cultural activities related to all the arts: music , visual arts, performing arts and the written word.

In 1979 CE, the Royal Society of Fine Arts was established to promote visual arts in Jordan and other countries in the region. It has links with major art galleries around the world in order to encourage artists from different cultures to learn from each other. The Jordan National Gallery of Fine Arts is one of the most important art museums in the Middle East. The collection includes over 2,000 works of art, including paintings, sculptures, photographs, installations, textiles and ceramics, by more than 800 artists from 59 countries. In 2013 CE, it held Jordan's largest art exhibition called ' 70 years of contemporary Jordanian Art'. Until the 1990s, most Jordanian literature was only available in Arabic. However, thanks to the project of Translation from Arabic, many Jordanian plays, novels, short stories and poems are now translated into English, and people all over the world are able to read and appreciate <u>them</u>.

Every year, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation chooses a different Arab city as the Arab Cultural Capital. In 2002 CE, the city of Amman was awarded this title. Jordan has a centuries –old musical heritage. The National Music Conservatory opened in 1986 CE, making it possible for more Jordanian students to study music seriously. In 1987 CE, the National Centre for Culture and Arts was created, which showcases theatre and dance in Jordan and in the region. Realising the value of art and culture, Jordan decided to offer Jordanians and the world an annual arts festival. In 1981 CE, Jerash Festival for Culture and Arts was founded. This three – weeklong summer programme is one of the largest cultural activities in the region. It takes place in the important archaeological site of Jerash, which underlines the close relationship between the arts and Jordan's cultural history.
