Obesity/Overweight

Over the last few years, there has been a dramatic increase in the number of overweight people in the world. This can be the reason of unhealthy eating habits and lack of physical activity. Obesity is a major health problem. It is a risk factor for diabetes, stroke and heart disease.

Consumption of junk foods is the number one cause of obesity. Junk or fast foods are rich in calories and unhealthy fats. When we consume more calories than our body can burn, it will convert the calories into fat. As a result people who consume calorie rich foods gain weight.

Late night dinners are another cause of overweight. When we have a heavy meal immediately before going to bed, the body does not get an opportunity to burn it. Most of us have jobs that allow us to spend our entire day in a chair. This lack of physical activity reduces our requirement for calories. omar jawarneh

Limiting the consumption of calories and making physical activity is the only way to fight obesity. Our bodies are designed to move. When we exercise, we do not only burn the calories but also reduce our risk for a lot of illnesses like diabetes and heart disease. We must make an effort to stay away from fatty foods. In conclusion, while it is true that the number of obese people is on the rise this problem can be tackled by making appropriate changes to our lifestyle and eating habits.

Complementary medicine/ alternative/homoeopathy

Some complementary practices have been studied and tested, but most have not been studied with well-designed trials. That means there are still many questions about these practices. However the negative side to alternative medicine is that there is limited amount of scientific facts and research showing detailed study of a certain herb. So before using you need to consult your doctor to make sure it's ok for you to use.

There are many advantages of complementary medicine such as it teaches you to become more responsible for your health and it may not be as costly as modern treatments and medications.
