

Zero Conditional Clause

-If / When + Present simple.

This conditional is used when the result will always happens .

It describes what happens in general

EX: "If water reaches 100 de-grees , it boils ." (It is always true there cant be a different result sometimes) .

First Conditional Clause

It's used to talk about things which might happen in the future . Of course , we can't know what will happen in the future .

It describes a specific situation.

EX: If I study today , I'll go to the game tonight .
