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Passive

Modal verbs + passive infinitive

MODAL VERBS :

Will – would

Can – could

Shall – should

May – might

Ought to / must

Passive —————> object + modal verbs + be + verb3

We use the **passive** :

1. When we don't know who does the action .
2. When we don't care who does the action.
3. When we know who does the action but we don't want to say.

Example :

Active : Ahmad will buy a new car.

Passive : a new car will be bought tomorrow.

Question : change into passive :

1. The kids should write the letters .

The letters

2. They can paint this picture .

The picture

3. Laila will have a new job next month.

A new job

4. The teacher might meet the parents tomorrow .

The parents

5. They could win the match .

The match

The answers :

1. Should be written .
2. Can be painted .
3. Will be had .
4. Might be met.
5. Could be won .
