Modals of deduction

MUST, MIGHT, and CAN'T

1. MUST

We use **must** when we are almost sure about something which is true.

Ex : *

- My grandfather, who is 80 years old, he has been working all day in the garden. He **must** be exhausted .
- **He has four big houses and three modern cars. He be rich.**

2. CAN'T

We use **can't** when we are almost sure that something is not true.

Ex:

- You have been sleeping all day. You **can't be tired**.
- My aunt lives in a very simple and small house . she Be rich .

3. MIGHT

We use **might** when are unsure whether something is true or not..

Ex :

- They are engaged recently . they get married next month .
- I think she isn't well nowadays . she come to the party.
