Past simple / past perfect

1. Past simple :

a. Affirmative :

Subject + verb 2 + object + complement.

- Ex : My sister **caught** the ball yesterday .

b. Negative :

Subject + didn't + base + complement .

- Ex : My sister **didn't catch** the ball yesterday .

c. Interrogative :

Did + Subject + base + complement ?

- Ex : **Did** My sister **catch** the ball yesterday ?

2. Past perfect :

a. Affirmative :

Subject + had + verb3 + complement .

- Ex : They **had won** the match .

b. Negative :

Subject + hadn't + verb3 + complement .

- Ex : They **hadn't won** the match .

c. Interrogative :

Had + Subject + verb3 + complement ?

- Ex : Had they won the match ?

- **Past simple** or **past perfect** using conjunctions : **because / before** :

1. Use before before the past simple.

before + past perfect , past simple.

Ex : **Before** he **came** here, I had washed all the dishes.

2. Use because after the past simple :

Because + past simple , past perfect.

Ex : Ali **was** sad **because** he hadn't done his homework.

2. Before he (sing) a song, he *had played* the guitar.
3. I (wash) the floor because the painter had gone.
