Third conditional

- if + past perfect, ...would + have + past participle(v3)

past perfect → subject + had + v3

1. If she **had studied**, she **would have passed** the exam.
(but, really we know she didn't study and so she didn't pass).
2. If I **hadn't eaten** so much, I **wouldn't have felt** sick.
(but I did eat a lot, and so I did feel sick).

Would have + past participle if + past perfect.

- *I **would have come** to the meeting if you **had told** me about it.*
- *if you **had told** me about it, I **would have come** to the meeting*
